



At any one time of the year, the Windsor is home to many migratory birds and our latest is the lbis. The Sacred lbis has formed a colony on the Lake View Island and turned it into a breeding site with many eggs and juveniles. For those of you who have taken up this hobby or would want to try it out, the best time for birding is early in the morning at 06:30 am - 08:00 am and late in the evening at 03:30pm - 6:00 pm.





Mika Coffee farm visit

Ever been to a Coffee farm visit? Well, Windsor offers coffee visits at Mika Coffee Farm, the visits are pre arranged and carried out as an individual or group visits to the farm. The farm tour covers the establishment of coffee trees, practices on the coffee tree, and ends with sorting, pulping, grading and storage of the coffee bean, which fascinates many who visit the farm. The tour is carried out by the farm manager Mr. Murage whose vast knowledge of coffee, highly impresses everyone. Our visitors have come to him with numerous questions to which he answers to great detail.

After touring the farm, the visitors get sample coffee brewed from the Mika coffee and are also treated to a delicious packed lunch from at the Windsor Hotel. Thereafter our guests proceed to the Mika Day Care Centre which caters for the farm workers children. The centre has about 20 children aged between 3 years and 6 years. What an expereince this can be for you and your friends.
